#### 2. AUTHORIZATIONS

2.1 Dr. Bowen reviewed the details of the one time retirement incentive offered to the Fillmore Faculty Association and reported that the incentive was presented to faculty at a recent meeting.

A motion was made by Dean, seconded by Cronk, authorizing the Interim Superintendent to sign a memorandum of agreement between the District and the Fillmore Faculty Association to establish a one-time only District-offered retirement incentive for Association members who retire no later than June 30, 2012, according to criteria specifically itemized in the memorandum.

#### 4. **BUSINESS/FINANCE**

4.1 Business Manager Tom Ricketts presented the financials through January 31, 2012 as well as the Monthly Cash Flow Report through January 2012. He noted that submission of Property Tax Cap date to the NYS Comptroller should occur March 1 and that on March 9 he will attend a Health Insurance meeting which should reveal rates for 2012.
