Head Lice Policy

- Students found to have live head lice will be excluded from school. A parent or guardian will be called to pick the student up.
- The parent or guardian will be given written and verbal instructions regarding the appropriate treatment of head lice and the proper care of the environment and personal items.
- A parent or guardian must accompany the student to school the next day to be
 examined by the school nurse. Should any lice be found, parents will be required to take
 the child home and continue treatment of the live lice.
- The student shall not return to school or take the school bus until the school nurse clears them.
- In grades PK 12 the nurse will check the appropriate student contacts.
- As always, the student's privacy will be safeguarded.
