1.1 Mrs. Wendy Reinbold addressed the Board regarding the possible mandate of the HPV vaccine for all students age 11 and older. She asked the Board to please write letters to Albany to oppose this mandate.

2.1 Mr. Jarrett Vosburg and Miss Desi Lyman presented the proposed senior trip intinerary to the Board. The senior trip will take place April 30<sup>th</sup> – May 3<sup>rd</sup> and they will be traveling to Ocean City and Baltimore, Maryland.

## 3. DISCUSSION/WORK SESSION:

## 3.1 Administrators' Reports:

# Mrs. Aylor, PK-12 Principal

- Mrs. Aylor shared the success that our student's extra-curricular activities have had over the last few weeks.
- Mrs. Aylor stated that her November PK-6 Newsletter is in the dropbox.
- Mrs. Aylor shared the Honor Roll for the first ten weeks of school.
- Mrs. Aylor talked about the new program Celebrating Learning and Student Success (CLASS) that the elementary students are involved in.
- Mrs. Aylor shared her Friday Features from the last month.

## Mr. Talbot, PK-12 Assistant Principal

- Mr. Talbot shared that he went with six of the NHS students to the Methodist Church to help unload the food truck. He stated it was another great opportunity to get to know more of the community.
- Mr. Talbot talked about the LEGO League competition at Houghton College that he and Mrs. Hardy attended this past weekend. We have one team advancing to Rochester.
- Mr. Talbot shared that he attended the first of three-half day sessions with Dr. Colleen Taggerty and other local new administrators as part of the New Administrator Group.
- Mr. Talbot shared that he will be presenting at NYSCATE (The New York State
  Association for Computers and Technologies in Education) next week sharing not only
  his previous STEAM experiences but also sharing some of the great technology he has
  seen used at Fillmore. Mrs. Hardy and Mr. Burr will also be attending NYSCATE with
  Mr. Talbot.

## Mrs. Hardy, Director of Technology

- Mrs. Hardy shared that she attended the LEGO League competition with Mr. Talbot this past weekend.
- Mrs. Hardy said that the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of the Smart School has been submitted and will hopefully be discussed soon at NYSED in December.
- Mrs. Hardy stated that the Virtual Field Trips are going strong. We've had 4 trips in one week.
- Mrs. Hardy shared that she attended a presentation on Cybersecurity Threats and Ransomware. They discussed what filters needed to be in place to stop these threats. Mrs. Hardy states that we also have rules in place for K-8 stopping outside senders from emailing students to avoid ransomware. Mrs. Hardy is also providing a handout to teachers to share with students on how to look for phishing emails as educating the user is the best filter.

### Mrs. West, CSE Chair

- Mrs. West talked about the technology implementation in special education. Mrs. West stated that each year our special education teachers try to find creative ways to implement testing accommodations while still maintaining instruction in their classrooms.
- Mrs. West talked about the different instructional coaches that come to Fillmore a few times a month to help out the teachers.

## 3.2 Superintendent's Report: Mr. Dodge

- Mr. Dodge passed around a Thank You card from the boys' soccer team.
- Mr. Dodge shared that he attended the NHS assembly where David Kelley, a 3-Star General, was the guest speaker. Mr. Dodge also shared that he attended NTHS ceremony at the BOCES Center in Belmont.
- Mr. Dodge shared that at next month's meeting we will recognize both soccer teams and the FFA students.
- Mr. Dodge stated that he will have Clark Patterson Lee attend an upcoming meeting to provide an update on the project and also introduce Levi, Project Manager.
- Mr. Dodge talked about Mr. Scott Payne, the new BOCES Superintendent, wanting to come to a future meeting to spend a few minutes and introduce himself to the Board.

#### 3.3 Work Session

- Mr. Dodge talked about a recent bus stop complaint. Mr. Dodge stated that he called the county and had them install bus stop warning signs and has also asked the NYS Police if they will patrol the area more often. The new bus stop now works better for both the student and the bus.

- Mr. Dodge shared Policy 7440- Election Law which requires local Boards of Education to adopt a policy to promote student voter registration and pre-registration. Mr. Dodge stated that he added the League of Women Voters to illustrate how we meet the requirement.
- Mr. Dodge briefly talked about the Greeter candidate. Mr. Dodge said she is a Fillmore Graduate and has two children, one of which is in school now.
- Mr. Dodge shared that the new safety survey is ready to send out.
