2. Is a tomato a fruit or a vegetable?

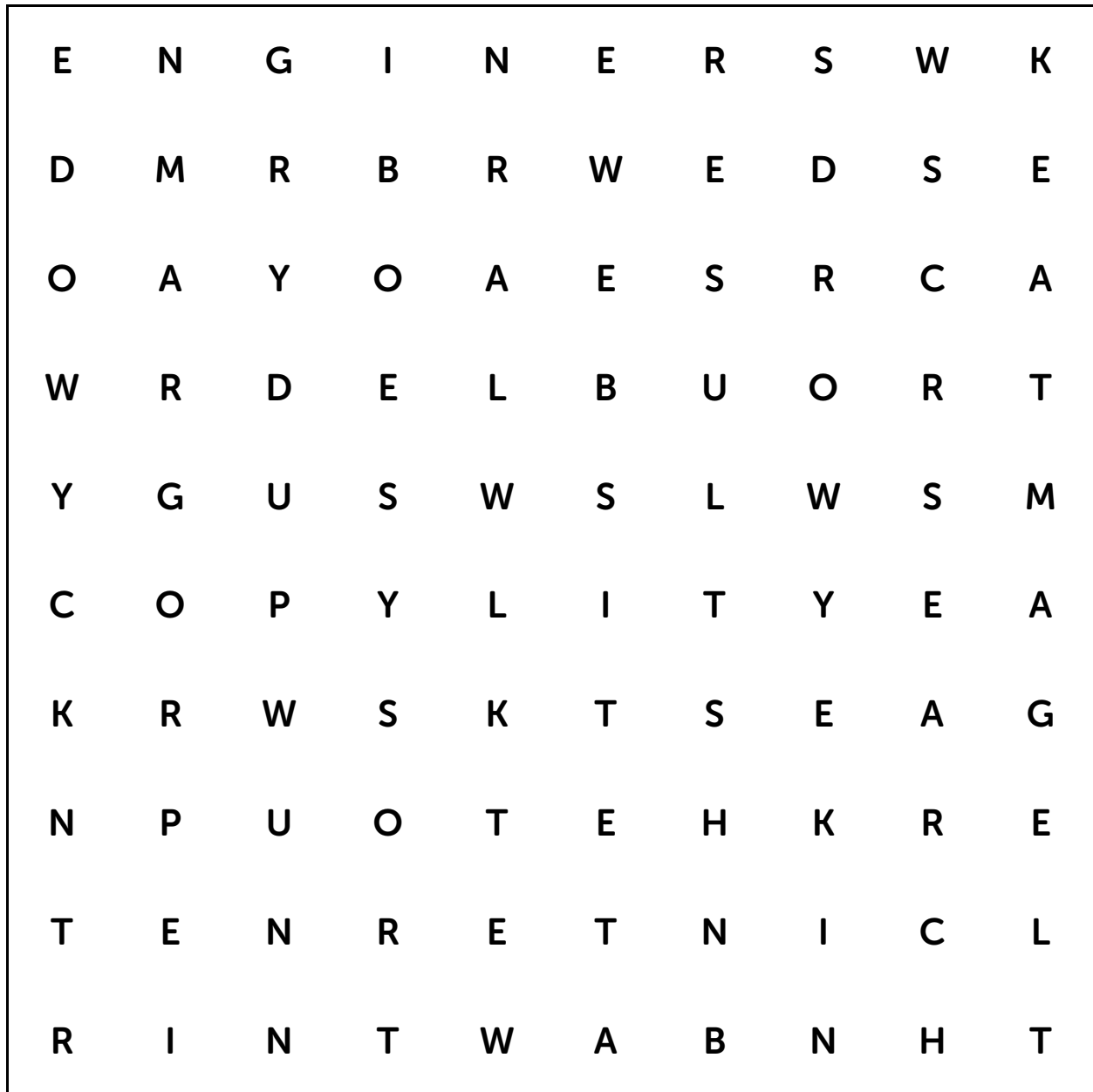
