**NOTE TO APPLICANT:** Awarded to a student attending high school in Allegany County who will be enrolling in a vocational or technical program at Alfred State College, with preference given to a student who attended BOCES while in high school. To be eligible for this \$500 scholarship (Alfred State will match the award with a \$500 contribution), applicant must be a high school senior who plans to attend Alfred State College as a full-time student during the school year following high school graduation.

**ESSAY:** The essay should discuss your interest in your major area of study and the occupation you propose to pursue after graduation. That is, what are your long-term goals and how do you hope to achieve them? The essay may also include any other information that is relevant to your career plans. The essay should be type-written or computer-printed, no more than 500 words, and double spaced. Put your name at the top of the page.

**TRANSCRIPT:** Ask your counselor to attach a copy of your transcript with SAT and/or ACT scores.

**DEADLINE:** Submit the completed application and essay to your counselor by April 1, 2021.
