

Below are some important technology updates during school closure.

1. Free Wi-Fi Access Points are in the following locations:

- Fillmore CSD's front and back parking lots available 24/7
- Centerville Fire Hall parking lot available 24/7 – provided by *Win Win Wireless LLC* by mid-week
- Short Tract Fire Hall from 1 p.m. – 3 p.m. Monday-Friday while the FCS Wi-Fi Bus is in the lot
- Houghton Fire Hall from 1 p.m. – 3 p.m. Monday-Friday while the FCS Wi-Fi Bus is in the lot

Students can log into the Fillmore CSD Wi-Fi using their individual credentials. Families can log into the Guest Wi-Fi with:

Username: Visitor
Password: Green14

2. Student laptops that are still in the school building:

We can arrange a pickup of a laptop in our elementary bus loop between the hours of 10 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. Please call the school at **585-567-2289** and let the office know where the student laptop is in the school, and we will be sure to have the laptop ready for pickup.

3. Student credentials to log into laptops and email:

Student usernames are first initial and last name followed by their 2 digit grad year @fillmorecsd. For example:

Username: jdoe20@fillmorecsd.org (example if student was John Doe graduating in 2020)
Password: Last 6 digits of the student's school ID number

4. Accessing Microsoft Teams:

Students should click on the O365 shortcut on the school's laptop and use the email log in and then click on Teams. If students are using a different device, they can go to login.microsoftonline.com and use the same student log in credentials anytime/anywhere.
