# Junie Babbitt










# Our Flag by Kallie Pastorius


# **The Poppy**

The Remembrance Day symbolism of the poppy started with a poem written by a World War I brigade surgeon who was struck by the sight of the red flowers growing on a ravaged battlefield. Across northern France and Flanders (northern Belgium), the brutal clashes between Allied and Central Powers soldiers ripped up fields and forests, tearing up trees and plants and wreaking havoc on the soil beneath. But in the warm early spring of 1915, bright red flowers began peeking through the battle-scarred land. Papaver rhoeas, commonly known as the Flanders poppy.

But left behind lots of despair.





Only to be protected by our Rangers.


We might not see it but they do.

Dear Veterans,


Thank you so much for everything you've done for our country. We are honored that you served for us. The military is scary, for sure, but I just want to say thank you.




